Re: Phase 1A of the Common Core Technology Plan

I understand that the Los Angeles Unified School District is considering a large scale technology integration project which would rely almost exclusively on WiFi or wireless technologies. I urge you to reconsider and to instead choose a system that is based on safer hardwired alternatives.

This is because, like cell phones, WIFI emits RF radiofrequency microwave radiation, which thousands of studies have shown to be dangerous, especially in the case of chronic exposure. Children are much more vulnerable due to a number of reasons including thinner skulls, undeveloped immune systems, and rapidly dividing cells. Schools are required to provide a safe learning environment, and the science shows that WiFi is not safe.

Scientists and medical doctors around the world advise against the use of WIFI in schools. Please refer to their testimony in attached 6-page document.
